




Population engaging in air travel has greatly increased



The period after EU enlargement saw a convergence between the original 15 EU member states and the new 10 accession member states in 2004.

This graph shows that the ratio of Population to Passengers over 20 years (2000-2019) converged, as more and more of the population from the Accession 10 (A10) countries were able to use aviation as a means of transport.

Accession Countries

In 2004, the population divided by passengers (Pax) for A10 countries was 1.87, while in 2019, it decreased significantly to 0.59. This indicates a significant increase in passenger numbers relative to the population in A10 countries. The decrease from 2004 to 2019 is approximately 68.4%.


EU15 Countries

Similar to A10 countries, this indicates a notable decrease in the ratio of population to passengers over this period for EU12 countries, suggesting a significant increase in passenger numbers relative to the population. The decrease from 2004 to 2019 is approximately 39.5%.



Joining the EU played a pivotal role in the growth of air travel in accession countries causing in a much higher growth rate of passengers compared to EU15 countries.

Growth in Airport Passenger Volumes, 2004 to 2019






Accession countries, especially post-enlargement, exhibited higher growth rates compared to EU15 countries post enlargement, indicating a more rapid expansion of the passenger market in these countries. This may be attributed to various factors such as economic development, infrastructure improvements, and increased integration into the EU market.
