

ACI EUROPE is the European region of Airports Council International (ACI), the only worldwide professional association of airport operators. ACI EUROPE represents over 500 airports in 55 countries. Our members facilitate over 90% of commercial air traffic in Europe. Air transport supports 13.5 million jobs, generating €886 billion in European economic activity (4.4% of GDP). In response to the Climate Emergency, in June 2019 our members committed to achieving Net Zero carbon emissions for operations under their control by 2050, without offsetting.







We actively work on a day-to-day basis with the institutions of the European Union, as well as the European Civil Aviation Conference (ECAC), the European Organisation for the Safety of Air Navigation (EUROCONTROL), the European Union Aviation Safety Agency (EASA), the SESAR 3 Joint Undertaking and all the national civil aviation authorities in Europe. Colleagues in ACI World pursue the same mission with the International Civil Aviation Organization of the United Nations (ICAO) and other world organisations.









We maintain close relationships with many national airport operator associations and with a number of organisations, with interests related to the aviation industry.

These include the Aerospace and Defence Industries Association of Europe (ASD), Air Transport Action Group (ATAG), Airlines 4 Europe (A4E), the International Air Transport Association (IATA), the European Regions Airline Association (ERA), Airlines International Representation in Europe (AIRE), the Civil Air Navigation Services Organisation (CANSO), Airport Regions Conference (ARC), European Disability Forum (EDF), the European Travel Retail Council (ETRC), the Assembly of European Regions (AER) and the General Directorate of State Airports Authority (DHMI).

We as ACI EUROPE, maintain regular dialogue on international issues with other regions of Airports Council International (ACI AFRICA, ACI ASIA-PACIFIC & MIDDLE EAST, ACI LATIN AMERICA & CARIBBEAN and ACI NORTH AMERICA) and our global coordination office, ACI WORLD.
